Maria I. Dagla is **Associate Professor** at **Midwifery Department**, in School of Health and Welfare Sciences, in **University of West Attica** (UNI.W.A.). She has obtained two *MSc* degrees, one in ‘Bioethics’ and the other in ‘Applied Public Health’. She holds a **Ph.D in ‘Bioethics’**. She has an extensive clinical experience in public and private midwifery settings, providing antenatal, perinatal and postpartum midwifery care services (e.g. preparation for parenthood, breastfeeding counselling, etc). She is **a member of the Steering Committee of the MSc Program** in ‘Advanced and Evidence Based Midwifery Care’, **the research ‘Laboratory of Midwifery Care during Antenatal and Post natal period- Breastfeeding’** and **co-founder and President of the Board of Directors in the Non Profit Organization ‘Fainareti’**, with the aim of research and intervention for the promotion of the health of women and their families in Greece.

Since 2003, she has taught a variety of **clinical courses** in midwifery and neonatal care e.g., “Postpartum Midwifery Care”, “Neonatal Care”, “Neonatal Care in NICU”, “Pediatric Nursing”, Postpartum Midwifery Care - Promotion of breastfeeding”, “Community Midwifery Care”, etc. Moreover, she has taught **undergraduate and postgraduate theoretical courses** in “Pediatric Nursing”, “Evidenced Based Clinical Decision Making”, “Neonatal Care”, “Postpartum Midwifery Care”, “Bioethics in Healthcare”, “Deontology in Midwifery”, “Early Interventions in Mother-Infant Relationship”, “Sociological Approach in Reproductive Period”, “Research Methodology”, etc. Also, she has published research articles and reviews (~70) with plethora of citations and has written (as author and co-author) 3 books and 2 chapters in books. She has also presented numerous works in international congresses and he has participated in the

scientific and organizing committees in various national congresses. She is reviewer in *Midwifery Journal* and *Pediatrics* (the official journal of the American Academy of Pediatrics), and also in other eight scientific journals.
